**2. Programmes/Events organized by the departments:**

**i) Department of Botany:**

- The department of Botany actively participated in each and every program of the college. Department faculties include two clock hour basis lecturers.
- Department started the session with field visit after rain on 2<sup>nd</sup> August 2011 to familiarize the students with ephemeral plants which grow only in stagnant water and for short time, also for the students to know how the Algae and Fungi grow in nature.
- Department celebrated the Teachers Day on 5<sup>th</sup> of September, the birth anniversary of Dr Sarvapalli Radhakrishnan. On this occasion, students organized 'Self Governance Day' where all departments were run by students and lectures were given by students. In this program, students actively participated.
- Students also gave seminars on various topics of syllabus. Seminar is organized by department in the month of December every session as it helps to increase stage presence and knowledge of the students.
- Department also arranges guest lectures for students on various topics though department doesn't have permanent faculties but our focus was to develop students knowledge in botany which helps them in future.

**ii) Department of Physics:**

- The first event was "Fun with Physics". Our students gave informative and entertaining physics presentations with hands-on demonstrations in Vishvashanti Vidyalaya, Saoli which was really the fun for the school level students. Participated undergraduates returned to their studies with more enthusiasm and motivation. Its main purpose was to provide a solid foundation for more advanced study. This event was held on September 5<sup>th</sup> to be the part of celebration of Teacher's Day.

- The student's seminar was arranged in the month of October as well as in January. Students were actively participated in the seminar and explained the topics with the help of charts. Female students seemed to be very active in such seminars and also used new techniques of learning and teaching such as power point presentations. This sort of seminars improve the communicative skills and increases the stage daring of the students.

#### **ii) Department of Chemistry:**

The academic session of the college began in the month of June in this year.

- In this year department had organized different activities for the overall development of students. The department had organized a seminar in the month of September and February. On the occasion of Dr. Sarvapalli Radhakrishnan birth anniversary, students from our department were participated in seminar competition organized by the college. The department had active participation in all the programmes organized by the college.
- As the Chemistry is one of the major subjects in the college and is the compulsory subject for all the students of science faculty, we planned to start P.G. courses and tried to appoint permanent teachers to serve quality educations to the students.
- It is one of the biggest departments in the college, so it played a leading role in many activities like organizing seminars, poster presentation etc. Every year results of UG classes are much better than university results. After completing graduation, students can appear for various competitive examinations like Indian Forest Services, Indian Administrative Services conducted by UPSC. He/she can also go for higher courses like M.Sc (Chemistry), M.Sc. (Chemical Technology). Amongst the careers available to a person who enjoys outdoor positions as project assistant, Research scholar, Lab attendant, Person with mathematical background might find defence academy and other exciting fields.

#### **iv) Department of Zoology:**

- A local study to nearby water body was being organized to study the flora and fauna of that ecosystem. The students had made regular visit to these water bodies to collect the tadpoles, the water samples from various ponds and water bodies was being collected to do the water analysis.
