

Road Safety Awareness Campaign at Chakpiranji Village

A road safety campaign was carried out at Chakpiranji Taluka Savli on 23/04/2022, Saturday, through the Physics Department of the Rashtrapita Mahatma Gandhi Arts, Commerce and Science College Savli. About 30 undergraduate and postgraduate students from department of Physics were participated in this event. The purpose of this activity is not only to spread the awareness about the importance of luminance radium tapes or increase in accidental rate but also to imbibe the moral responsibility of the youth towards the society.

The number of road accidents is increasing day by day and one of the major reasons for this is non-installation of radium panels on the roads, the number of accidents is increasing and there is a huge loss of life and property. The installation of radium panels and signs are seen everywhere on the national highways but such signs are not erected on the roads in rural areas, hence the accidents is more in these areas. Similarly, vehicles used in rural areas like bullock carts, bicycles and tractor trolleys do not have any kind of reflectors on the rear side, and this leads to accidents and loss of life. Therefore, the Department of Physics has undertaken an awareness campaign about this.

During the campaign, first of all the students of Zilla Parishad schools were introduced to road safety by the head of the physics department of the college and college students provided detailed guidance on how to use radium to prevent road accidents. After this the villagers were also guided about this and the students also applied radium to the bullock carts, bicycles and tractor trolleys of the village. It was hoped that if this campaign was implemented in every village, accidents on the roads at night would be avoided.
