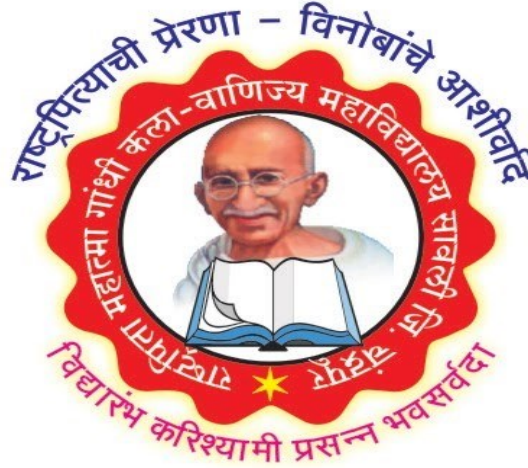

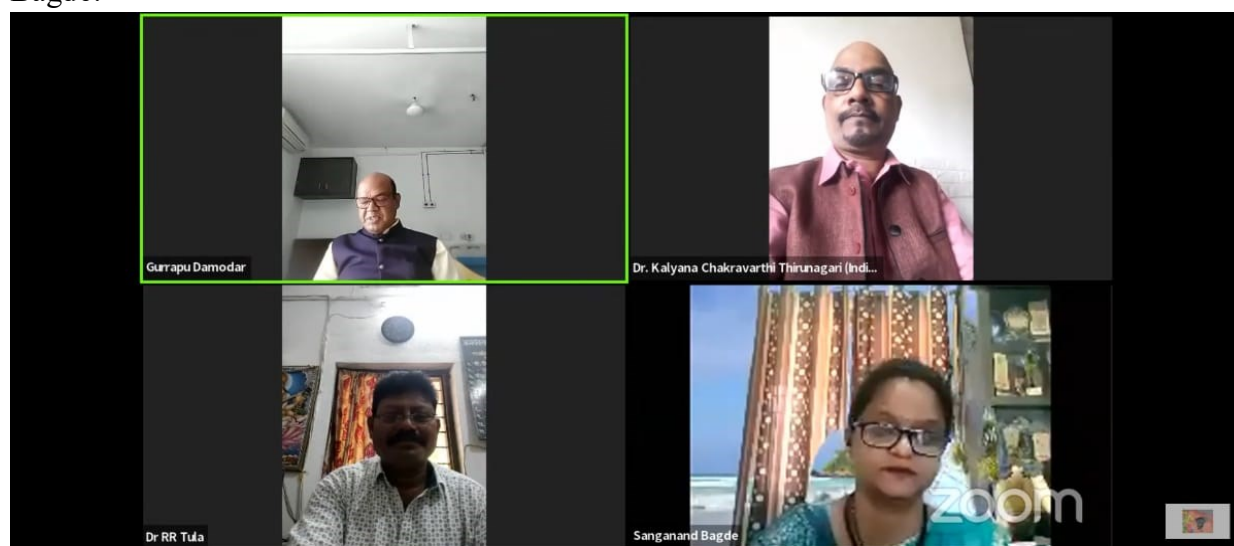

Key Note Speaker

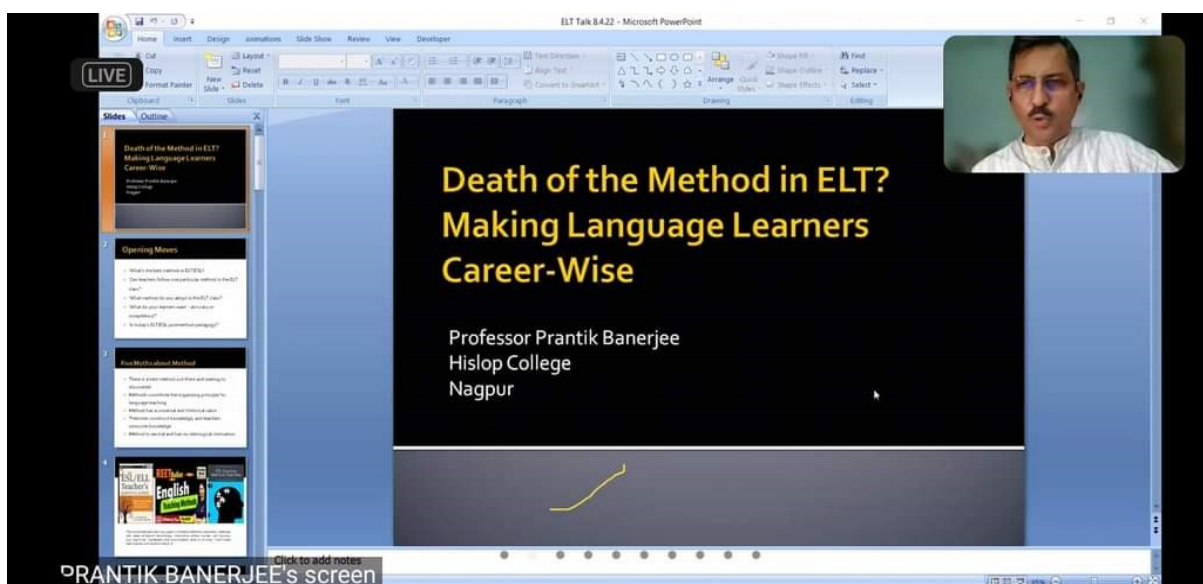
Dr. G Damodar, Vice Chancellor, Chaitanya Deemed To Be University, Warangal
